The day centre for the homeless in Woodhouse Road, Finchley is now open. Homeless people and those living in cramped bed and breakfast accommodation now have a centre where they can buy food, have a shower, receive medical checks and counselling, and meet other people in clean and comfortable surroundings.

There will be a ban on drinking and drugs and high standards will be maintained with offenders receiving warnings or being banned from the centre.

On Thursday 19th June there was an open day and visitors praised the centre for it clean and welcoming atmosphere.

This centre was first planned for the Market Place off of East End Road, but because of protests from local residents the site was changed to Woodhouse Road.

In spite of fresh controversy and protested it went ahead and now, as one local householder said, "We protested and it is now open so we wait and see". The centre is funded by the
