Once again the St Pancras and Islington cemetery in the High Road, has become a target for vandalism and robberies.

During a recent weekend they caused an estimated £40,000 of damage to a bronze mausoleum door and granite block.

The reception and staff room were broken into and a motor cycle set on fire. But as Richard Baldwin, the cemetery Manager told the Archer, "This cemetery covers a vast area and would need 24 hour security to solve the problem. We are having talks with the police on ways to improve security. To get the security patrol I would really like is question of money" said Mr Baldwin.


