Barnet Council have abandoned plans to build a library instead of the Arts Depot at the former Gaumont cinema site at Tally Ho Corner. The Council, controlled by the Conservatives since the May local elections, was concerned about the running costs of the Arts Depot and proposed building a library instead. However, consultants, who had been paid £100,000 by the Council, said that the work was too advanced and that changing the plans would be a big gamble. In addition, they considered that the Council's plans for a library could have cost more.
