Cash machine fraud

Police have issued a warning about cash machine fraud, which rose by 17% last year. Criminals are now fitting false fronts on to cash machines that are so well made they look genuine. These devices steal your card, which is then used at other ATMs. Unsuspecting customers do not realise their card has been stolen, believing that the bank has retained it for some reason.

The false fronts are usually fitted with tiny cameras. These are directed at the keypad to photograph your pin number. Alternatively, one of the criminals will look over your shoulder to obtain the pin number.

ATM advice

Police advise you to be alert when using cash machines. If approached by anybody while queuing to use the machine or while using it, don't respond to any of the advice they give you. Examine the ATM carefully, checking for stick-on boxes or card entry slots. Have a look at the top of the ATM where tiny
