£250 for a bag of

Police have issued a warning about a scam that tricks people into handing over hundreds of pounds for items worth only pennies.

Typically, the victim of the scam is approached in the street and asked if they would like to buy a laptop at half price. They are taken to a parked car and shown a new laptop in good working condition. The victim goes to the bank to get the cash, returns to the car and buys it, but when they get home and open the bag, there's no laptop.

Police report that victims have handed over as much as £600 for a laptop bag containing bottles of water, magazines,

catalogues or bricks. One man paid £250 for a bag of onions. To date, the scam has been operating in N22, N4 and N11 but could happen anywhere.

"We must advise extreme caution if you are approached by anyone in the street trying to sell something," said DC Suzie Chantry, of Haringey CID. "Even if you do get the item you are paying for, there is a real danger that you could be buying stolen property, which means you could be arrested on suspicion of handling stolen goods.'
