# Confusion over library consultation

As inevitable cutbacks approach, library users eager to say what they want from the service in East Finchley are feeling angry and dismayed. Last month we reported that Barnet Council had delayed issuing paper consultation forms for a month, in case the public confused them with national questionnaires about provision for youth.

When the forms eventually arrived, notices were not immediately put up in the library. There are small notices up now but the paper forms are not on display. Staff say that they are under instructions only to give them out on request.

There is also confusion about dates. When the survey was launched, the closing date was given as the end of November and this is still the time period given online. The end date on library notices, however, which actually start by talking about the online survey, is 17 December.

Typical of the comments around East Finchley has been: "If they don't get enough replies, they'll say we're not interested and will close the library down". This, of course, makes it all the more vital to get those responses in fast. Don't forget yours.

THE ARCHER asked Barnet for an explanation but none was available at the time of going to press.

## Older assembly

Barnet now has an Older People's Assembly to help people over 55 make their voices heard on issues that affect them, including health and social services.

Anyone over the age of 55 is invited to join, even if they are not already active in any other group. BOPA is especially looking for representatives from "harder to reach" groups, such as ethnic minorities, and those who are not normally able to attend meetings.
