Artsdepot funding to be cut

Barnet Council has announced plans to cut all core funding to artsdepot, the arts centre in North Finchley, from April 2011. The centre provides a wide variety of theatre, children's shows, comedy, dance, visual arts and music. It also runs a diverse range of courses and outreach programmes and has been recognised by the Mayor of London as a beacon of excellence.

"If this goes through, Barnet will be one of the largest councils in the country to spend nothing on the arts," said Nigel Cutting, the centre's director.

In the last financial year, artsdepot received £194,000 from the council, which is 11% of the annual turnover. About 25% of artsdepot's income comes from private trusts and foundations who value its work. The rest comes from box office sales and hires.

In 2009/2010 more than 110,000 people came through artdepot's doors, while the education and outreach departments worked with groups including young people with disabilities, refugees, young offenders, people with dementia and those excluded from mainstream education.

Shocking and shortsighted

Nigel Cutting said that he was shocked by the proposal as he had been in constant dialogue with Barnet Council for the last six months, but at no time had it been suggested that funding would be withdrawn in 2011. "Arts provision will need to take a share of the cuts, but this is hugely disproportionate and shortsighted, especially since artsdepot is a council initiative," he said.
