Man arrested after series of attacks

A man from Hornsey has been arrested following a series of vicious attacks on men in the Muswell Hill area. The first victim, a 67-year-old man, was found lying on the ground unconscious at 10am on 5 January, close to the gates of Alexandra Park, Alexandra Palace Way. A passer by discovered him and called the police. The man had serious head injuries and was taken to an east London hospital in a critical condition. On 31 January, an 84year-old man was found unconscious with severe head injuries by a member of the public, this time in Queens Wood, near Wood Vale. He was taken to a north London hospital.

Two other men were attacked in the Muswell Hill area during January, a 37-yearold and a 63-year-old, but both managed to escape with minor injuries. One of these attacks was in Queens Wood, and was also in broad daylight. When police appealed for any information that would help them find the attacker, they said the assaults were obviously linked because of their similarities.

On 4 February, shortly after the last attack, the 29year-old suspect was arrested and charged with two counts of attempted murder and GBH with intent and two counts of attempt to cause GBH with intent. He appeared at Brent Magistrates Court the following day, where the case was committed to the Central Criminal Court. He has been remanded in custody until he appears in court on 16 May.
