Bogus callers beg for money

The East Finchley Safer Neighbourhood Team (SNT) has received several reports of people knocking on doors and asking for money. The team is sure they are bogus callers and not genuine individuals in need of help.

Reasons given for needing money vary but all are 'emergencies' which are difficult to say no to, such as a sick relative to visit but no cash for the journey, or the person has just moved to a nearby address and has no money to put on a utilities key.

Descriptions of the callers vary greatly, suggesting that there are several operatives in the area. So far, none have been female, although the SNT says that women often use this method of getting money or gaining entry to a home.

"It is your discretion whether to give money or not, but we would strongly advise you

not to encourage this," said a spokesperson from the SNT. "If you have elderly or vulnerable family or neighbours you may wish to inform them. If you have any information about these callers please get in touch with us. If someone knocks at your door and you are unhappy with the reason they give you, please contact us or call the police nonemergency number 101."
