Bald Faced Stag, 69 High Road, N2 Alterations to rear parking area. Includes reduction of parking spaces to facilitate new patio, new grassed area with feature planting bed, and bin store. Alterations to ground floor rear fenestration. including new entrance doors and steps and opening, bi-folding replacement windows. Blocking up one north-facing window. Glazed lantern to flat roof of dining-room. 12 Deansway, N2

Creation of basement level with terrace above. Changes to rear windows and doors. Roof extension, involving replacing roof lights with two rear dormer windows.

## **New homes** on Fortis

Green

Planning applications have been submitted to turn the former Muswell Hill police station and the former Alexandra pub, both on Fortis Green, into homes (see left).

The police station will be converted into nine residential units and the pub and its flat above will be turned into two three-bedroom family homes.

# results

The Conservative Party has retained overall control of Barnet Council, but only just. In an evening of high drama as the results were announced on 23 May, the Conservatives were reduced to 32 councillors as Labour, despite making significant gains, fell short of gaining control. The Liberal Democrat presence on the council has been reduced to one.

In East Finchley, Labour councillors Allison Moore and Arjun Mittra were re-elected, with Alon Or-Bach becoming one of 18 new councillors in Barnet.

In the elections to the European Parliament that were held on the same day, the London constituency returned eight MEPs: four Labour, two Conservatives, one Green and one UKIP.
