## A1 accident witness appeal

Police are appealing for witnesses to a fatal collision, which occurred on the A1 Falloden Way, near the junction with Addison Way, early on the morning of Wednesday 15 July.

A45-year-old man, reported to be the driver of a red 'oldstyle' BMW 318, was taken to hospital where he later died from his injuries, after his car collided with a lamppost. No other vehicles are believed to have been involved.

The A1 was closed in both directions for several hours

following the crash, whilst an investigation took place, causing traffic chaos in much of the surrounding area.

# Watchdog finds holes in dentistry services

Help the Aged

Research carried out by Healthwatch Barnet, the local health and social care watchdog, has shown that access to NHS Dentistry in the borough still needs to be substantially improved.

In a mystery shopping survey of 50 dental practices, Healthwatch Barnet found that over half of practices were not accepting new NHS adult patients and just under half were not accepting new children as patients.

This contrasts sharply with the fact that over 90% of the practices were accepting both adult and children as new private patients.

**Funding frozen** 

Healthwatch Barnet spokesperson Mike Rich said: "The problem is not with capacity but with the fact that in spite of an increasingly growing population, there has not been any increase in funding for NHS Dental Services in the borough for 10 years.'

Access to dental appointments was not the only problem. Many practices did not have information on costs of treatment on display and not all surgeries agreed a treatment plan before treatment was offered

But it is not all doom and gloom: 82% of people recently report having had a good experience of local NHS dental services in Barnet according to a NHS England patient survey.

#### Recommendations

Healthwatch Barnet recommended that urgent consideration needs to be given to the amount of funding available for NHS Dentistry in Barnet and clear information about costs should be readily available to all patients when they attend a dental appointment. All patients should receive a clear written treatment plan, including costs, before any treatment is started.

studio space. Church Farm would be moved to a larger site nearby, either Danegrove Playing Field in East Barnet or Victoria Recreation Ground in New Barnet.

To maintain the continuity of service both the existing leisure centres would remain open while the new facilities were being built.

The consultation runs from now until 23 September. Residents are being asked to share their views on these proposals by completing an online questionnaire which can be found at engage.barnet.gov.uk or by picking up a paper copy from Church Farm, Copthall, Finchley Lido, Burnt Oak and Hendon leisure centres as well as the council's libraries.
