Michael McGrath, a resident of Ingram Road, told us: "Barnet Council would normally require up to 32 additional parking places to be included in a development of this size, yet the developer has proposed only two spaces. There will therefore be an additional 30 cars seeking parking in the streets around the station.

"Even if the future residents of this development are prevented from using the Controlled Parking Zone there will still be a significant impact in the evenings and on Sundays and in those streets that have only a 2-3pm restriction."
