Esso to close its garage on Church Lane

By Janet Maitland Last month we investigated a rumour that Tesco was planning to open a store on the site of the Esso garage at 217 High Road. At first Tesco's spokesperson told us confidently that yes, they were planning on opening an Express store.

They retracted this statement after realising they had confused North Finchley, where Tesco are opening a store, with East Finchley, where they are definitely not.

Hunt the garage

However, Esso has now confirmed that the garage on the corner of Church Lane and the High Road will close later this year.

"Closures of this kind can take some time to arrange, and it too soon for us to report on the likely future use of the site," said a spokesperson for Esso.

The Esso service station at the junction of the Great North Road and the A1 will continue to operate. There is also a BP garage on the North Circular eastbound carriageway near Strawberry Vale. Otherwise, the closest places to fill up are local supermarkets, which seem to be starting to dominate the petrol market nationally.

Back to the High Road Esso: all we can be certain of at the moment is that whatever the garage will be replaced with, it won't be a Tesco. What would readers like to see built on this site? The Alexandra, 1 Church Lane, N2 Change of use from A4 (drinking establishment) to A3 (restaurants and cafes). Two new canopy structures to rear. Rebuilding of existing new canopy. New roof to front patio arch.

18 Blandford Close, N2

One rear and one side dormer to facilitate loft conversion.

74 Brackenbury Road, N2

Roof extension, including rear dormers and two front roof lights. (Lawful Development Certificate).
