On Tuesday 3 March. Barnet was due to hold its crucially important budget meeting for the coming financial year. Because of the wonderful response to the 38 Degrees petition to save our libraries (over 8,000 signatures at the time of writing, in mid-February,) lead petitioner Alasdair Hill will have five minutes to ask the Council to reconsider its plans.

The public consultation into the council's library plans closed on 22 February and the latest news we have is that Barnet's final proposals will not be announced before June.
