## Language links with China

Christ's College Finchley has been chosen to become the home of one of 40 Confucius Classrooms in the UK, teaching Mandarin as a foreign language from September.

The project comes out of the school's links with the London School of Economics and the Confucius Institute for Business in London which have already enabled it to offer Mandarin to sixth formers, year sevens and parents.

Headteacher Samson Olu-sanya said the opening of the Confucius Classroom will give all students the chance to learn a new language that will be increasingly important in the modern world, along with a

greater appreciation of Chinese culture.

The school was chosen by Hanban University in China, the Chinese Language Council and the Chinese Embassy in London.
