While Kate Gidley was stuck behind a desk in her management job she was actually dreaming of standing at a freezing cold market stall trying to sell fresh fruit juice in the middle of winter.

Well, not exactly, but that's how it turned out when she decided to pack it all in and start her own business called Rocket Juice. Her first contact with customers was at a street market in Hackney and it just happened to be in the coldest month of the year.

She may not have made a huge profit then but she learned a lot and now her business is really taking off with her own juice-making team about to come on board and deals to sell her products in Tony's Continental and Budgens in East Finchley... and beyond.

Kate's juices come in five different fruit and vegetable combinations and are all cold pressed with no processing. Until now she has been making them at her home in Kitchener Road, N2.

The right name

"When I was in my previous job I was eating pre-packed food all the time and not really getting my five fruit or veg a day," said Kate. "I had a dream of being surrounded by nutrition and used to juice a lot with my housemates. Then one of them said why not try selling it, so I did.

"I called the business Rocket Juice because I wanted to give people the feel of the burst of energy and health they get when they drink it. It stays fresh for five days rather than sitting around on a shelf for weeks like processed juices."

Kate's dedicated juicemaking team will mean she can leave the kitchen juicer behind and focus on striking sales deals with cafés and gyms, as well as getting out to big events like
