## Extra police officer as patrols are stepped up

East Finchley has become one of the first areas in the capital to receive a second dedicated police officer as part of a plan that the Mayor of London's office claims will restore neighbourhood policing. PC Phil Scottow arrived in the area last month and joins PC John Kenny and PCSO Jan Lovell on patrol.

More than half of Londoners will have their extra officer in place before Christmas following an announcement by Sadiq Khan in July and the rest of the city will follow by the end of 2017.

### **Boost for the ward**

PCSO Jan Lovell welcomed her new colleague to East Finchley. She said: "This will be a big boost for the ward as it will enable us to address crime and anti-social behaviour more extensively."

At the same time, the police team's base on the High Road, N2, will accommodate the three-person teams for Finchley Church End and West Finchley wards and the area's new sergeant PS Paul Dodd.

PCSO Lovell says this means there will be extra officers on the streets and buses in N2 as the Church End and West Finchley officers travel to and from their wards.

### Ring-fenced officers

During the mayoral election campaign earlier this year, Mr Khan pledged to 'restore neighbourhood policing'. Former Mayor Boris Johnson cut staffing levels in 2011, leaving East Finchley's Safer Neighbourhood Team (SNT) with just PCSO Lovell and PC Kenny. He also introduced the system of drafting in extra borough-based officers when needed, meaning that East Finchley SNT staff often had to leave the ward and go elsewhere in Barnet, or into central London to deal with protests and major events.

Mr Khan said: "The new dedicated officers will be ring fenced for that ward, which means they can't leave the area. Officers who are known by their communities have local knowledge that helps to prevent and detect crime. They are the local eyes and ears of our security services and are essential to improving trust and confidence

in our police and keeping our communities safe."
